### NOTICE OF RACE

#### 1 Rules

The Regatta will be governed by the Rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing.

#### 2 Eligibility & Entry

The Regatta is open to dinghies, centerboard, multi-hull and keel boats. Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form and sending it, together with the required fee to:

Boats will be placed in divisions based on the type of boat and number of entries. Separate starts may be given to classes with 4 or more entrants registered. Class-Division assignments and start order shall be supplied to all competitors at the Competitors meeting on Saturday morning.

#### 3 Fees

The fee to race in the Regatta is \$55.00. Early entries received by May 8<sup>th</sup> may take a \$10 discount. US Sailing members receive a \$5.00 discount

#### 4 Schedule

Saturday, May 27	7:00AM - 8:30AM: Late Registration and Skipper Check In at Regatta Headquarters, at Brandy Creek Marina, Whiskeytown Lake, Redding, CA 9:00AM: Competitors Meeting, near Regatta Headquarters 10:30AM: Warning Signal, First Start 6:00PM: Social after racing - Dinner served at Regatta Headquarters.
Sunday, May 28	9:30AM - Warning Signal First Start. No warning after 1530.

**5 Sailing Instructions** Sailing Instructions will be supplied with the registration packet upon skipper check in and shall be available on the Whiskeytown Sailing Club website, [www.whiskeytownsailing.org](http://www.whiskeytownsailing.org) on or before May 25, 2017.

**6 Venue** The racing area shall be the main body of water of Whiskeytown Lake. A detailed map is available at [www.whiskeytownsailing.org](http://www.whiskeytownsailing.org) under the "Resources" tab.

**7 Courses** The courses will be selected from those published and furnished with the registration packet upon skipper check in.

**8 Scoring** Three races will be scheduled for each day. One race is required to constitute a regatta. When 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her races scored excluding her worst score. If fewer than 6 races are completed a boat's series score will be the total of her races. This changes RRS A2.

Handicap Fleets will be scored using the Portsmouth Yardstick.

**9 Prizes** Three trophies shall be awarded for each class.

**10 Disclaimer** Competitors shall participate in the regatta entirely at their own risk (see RRS 4, DECISION TO RACE). The organizing authority does not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with, prior to, during, or after the regatta.

**11 Insurance** All competitors shall maintain marine liability insurance throughout the regatta.

### ***Hospitality and Social – Not part of the Notice of Race***

**Parking** -- All vehicles parked at Whiskeytown are required to display a valid entrance pass on the driver's side of the dashboard. Permits are available at the Whiskeytown Visitor Center. A permit costs \$10.00/week.

**Launching** -- A launch Ramp is available at Brandy Creek Marina.

**Berthing** -- A limited number of guest slips at Brandy Creek Marina may be available. Contact Oak Bottom Marina no sooner than several days before the regatta (530-359-2008) or check with the regatta registration desk upon your arrival. Overnight dry storage is available in the Brandy Creek Marina parking lot.

**Camping** -- Camping is available at Whiskeytown National Recreation Area, NRA. [www.nps.gov/whis](http://www.nps.gov/whis). Individual campsites may be available at Oak Bottom: 530-359-2269. Limited RV camping is permitted at the south end of the Brandy Creek Marina parking lot. The fee is \$15 per night.

**Quagga or Zebra Mussels** -- Whiskeytown NRA requires all boats that enter Whiskeytown Lake complete the **Self Certification Forms**. This form is available from the Park web site; [www.nps.gov/whis](http://www.nps.gov/whis). Follow the directions and display the certification page in your windshield.
